## **EBT Cash Payments**

We're happy to announce that we're making EBT Cash available as an additional payment option. The payment buttons have been revised on both the point-of-sale and on the customer facing display to support having the additional EBT Cash payment option.

Below are some of the key changes made to support EBT Cash:

- EBT Cash payment option will function in either integrated or nonintegrated mode:
  - Integrated:
    - This means EBT Cash payment is processed through the paired pin pad via one of our integrated cc processors.
    - If you're already processing integrated EBT (Food), then EBT Cash will also be automatically integrated to be processed through the pin pad (except Basys).
    - The customer facing display will have EBT Cash enabled for customers to select as a payment option.
    - EBT Cash is not supported as a payment for returns or voids.
    - Sales receipts will display the card's balance and will mask the customer's name when a customer is associated.
    - Sales tax will not be applied when paid with EBT Cash.

- *Non-Integrated*:
  - EBT Cash payment option will display "Non-Integrated" on it, so the payment will not go through an integrated cc processor.
  - Basys & WorldPay are <u>not integrated</u> to support EBT Cash, so EBT Cash will only be available in nonintegration mode while using them.
  - The customer facing display will have EBT Cash disabled, since only integrated payment options are enabled on the CFD.
  - Sales tax will not be applied when paid with EBT Cash.



- Close Batch screen:
  - Will display one EBT tender that represents both EBT Cash & EBT Food.
  - When selecting the 3 lines, a screen will display that splits out all EBT payments, and gives visibility into which EBT type was used.
  - The print option will also split out the EBT payments, so a user can easily see which EBT type was used to make the payment.
- Zreport:
  - EBT will remain the same on the Zreport, but the amount will now account for both EBT Cash & EBT Food payments.
